Dr. David Christian “Chris” Hassell serves as the Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Chemical and Biological Defense, where he is responsible for providing direction, coordination, and advocacy for chemical and biological defense throughout DoD, as well as ensuring integration with interagency and international partners.

Prior to joining DoD, Dr. Hassell was an Assistant Director of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), where he served as Director of the FBI Laboratory. He previously held research and leadership positions in academia and industry, including the Oklahoma State University Multispectral Laboratories, Los Alamos National Laboratory and DuPont.
